WHAT?

WHEN?

Thursday night, July 16, will be an "early bird" Tempest dinner cruise to Berry's On Main restaurant in Norwalk. Tempests will roll out of the Quality Inn hotel parking lot at 5:00 pm, reservation at Berry's is at 5:30.

The Ames swap meet and time trials open on Friday, July 17. If you are racing, the track opens on Friday, July 17 for vendor set-up and test and tune for the racers. All are invited to gather for a fun, casual BBQ picnic on Friday evening at the Veterans Memorial Park not far from Summit Motorsports Park (see cost below). Our popular vote car show will be held on Saturday, July 18, with an awards ceremony at 4:00 pm.

WHO?

Little Indians invite all 1961-1963 Tempest and LeMans stock as well as modified cars to join us. If you are not a member of the Little Indians Chapter of POCl, you are still welcome and while we hope that you will consider joining our chapter, membership is not required to join our show, or our catered Friday evening BBQ.
